

Austin is ranked **15th in the nation** among fastest-growing metro job markets, boasting a YOY 2.1% increase between Aug. 2018 and Aug. 2019, resulting in 22,200 new jobs.



Austin is 6th in the nation among homebuilding prospects.

According to Austin Energy, as much as one-third of all the single-family homes and apartments built in Austin each year are green-rated homes. On average, rated homes are 9-18 percent more energy efficient than similar homes built to code. In addition, most new commercial and multi-family buildings downtown and in large-scale developments are green-building rated.
