Neighborhood Crime Summaries

The following sources provide various types of crime data. The amount of details provided and how far back information is available varies by source.

City of Austin

The Austin Police Department's online resource includes access to crime stats as early as 2003, the Traffic Viewer map that updates its incident listings every few minutes and Crime Report Viewer, an interactive mapping program with multiple search options and works best on Microsoft® browsers. austintexas.gov/department/crime-information

CrimeReports™

CrimeReports maps crime data from participating police departments with crime details varying based on the provider. Information from non-featured agencies goes back six months, whereas information from featured agencies goes back two years. Sex offender data is pulled from a national feed, updated weekly, and is available for all cities. In Central Texas, crime data is available for the following cities: Austin, Bastrop, Georgetown and Lakeway. crimereports.com

SpotCrime®

SpotCrime collects data from police departments, news reports and user-generated content, to plot their crime map. They also provide crime alerts for which can be received on a variety of social media platforms. Information for all cities across the nation is available. spotcrime.com
