• <u>Massachusetts' new Covid-19 Restrictions and Orders</u>

On November 6, 2020, a new Stay-At-Home advisory becomes effective, which limits travel outside the home between the hours of 10 PM – 5 AM. <u>https://www.mass.gov/news/stay-at-home-advisory</u>

Also effective on November 6, 2020, is Order #54, which limits private indoor gatherings at residences to 10 people and private outdoor gatherings to 25 people. To read this order, follow this link: <u>https://www.mass.gov/doc/covid-19-order-54/download</u>

Lastly, the Governor issued Order #55 which addressed face coverings. The revised order requires all persons to wear face-coverings in all public places, even where they are able to maintain 6 feet distance from one another. FBI Issues Warning

Noting an increase in telework from hotels, the FBI issued a public service announcement regarding the cybersecurity risk this could pose for guests.

"The Federal Bureau of Investigation is issuing this announcement to encourage Americans to exercise caution when using hotel wireless networks for telework," the PSA states. "FBI has observed a trend where individuals who were previously teleworking from home are beginning to telework from hotels. U.S. hotels, predominantly in major cities, have begun to advertise daytime room reservations for guests seeking a quiet, distraction-free work environment."
